

Canal D Offers a 10 000\$ Bursary to One Selected Francophone Project at Doc Circuit Montréal's Talent Lab

Montreal, Thursday, October 8, 2015 – The Montreal International Documentary Festival (RIDM) and Doc Circuit Montreal (DCM) are delighted to announce that the television channel Canal D will offer a 10 000\$ bursary to a selected Canadian francophone project presented at the Talent Lab in commemoration of the channel's 20th anniversary. The bursary will be awarded on Monday November 16th during the opening cocktail that kicks off Doc Circuit Montreal's professional market held from November 16-18.

The **Talent Lab** is an initiative of Doc Circuit Montreal, held from November 14-16. For this second edition, the Talent Lab will select a group of 40 emerging Canadian filmmakers following an application process. They will be invited to three full days of specialized conferences and exploratory workshops with a roster of artists and experts from RIDM and Doc Circuit Montreal programmes. Sessions will touch on the intricate aspects of being a documentary filmmaker today: the issues and ethics of using reality as a medium, and insider advice on how to best integrate understand and utilize both traditional and innovative industry structures.

The Talent Lab workshops will be moderated by producer, consultant and former Hot Docs director of programming **Sean Farnel** and by the award-winning producer **Isabelle Couture** (*The Amina Profile*). The call for submissions is open until October 18th.

Quebec-based television channel Canal D will offer the 10 000\$ bursary over the course of three years. **Jean-Pierre Laurendeau**, Canal D's Senior Programming Director and DCM figurehead for many years, is enthusiastic to see the channel support new documentary creation.
