

March Docville: *Seymour: An Introduction* by Ethan Hawke Thursday, March 26, 8 p.m., Cinéma Excentris



Montreal, Monday, March 9, 2015 – The Montreal International Documentary Festival (RIDM) monthly cycle, Docville, continues with *Seymour: An Introduction* a documentary by Ethan Hawke. Presented at Telluride and TIFF, this feature length film is Hawke's first take at documentary filmmaking.

Meet Seymour Bernstein: a virtuoso pianist, veteran New Yorker, and true original who gave up a successful concert career to teach music. In this wonderfully warm, witty, and intimate tribute from his friend, Ethan Hawke, Seymour shares unforgettable stories from his remarkable life and eye-opening words of wisdom, as well as insightful reflections on art, creativity, and the search for fulfillment.

Distributed by Métropole Films, the film will be released on March 27 2015.
