

## June Docville: *Dreamcatcher* by Kim Longinotto Thursday, June 25, 8 p.m. at Cinéma Excentris



Montreal, Wednesday, June 10, 2015 – The Montreal International Documentary Festival (RIDM) is pleased to announce the sixth (and second-last) Docville screening of the year, *Dreamcatcher* by Kim Longinotto. The new documentary by the director of the highly acclaimed *Salma* (2013) won the award for best director at Sundance earlier this year.

For more than 25 years, Brenda Myers-Powell, also known as Breezy, was a drug addict and prostitute. Now the head of the Dreamcatcher charitable organization in Chicago, she is a symbol of hope for hundreds of women and girls who want to get out of prostitution and change their lives. As we follow the charismatic Brenda, we enter the lives of young women who believe that prostitution is helping them survive. With unshakable determination and deep empathy, Brenda shows how one person can make a real difference in the lives of many others.
