

A NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FOR THE RIDM

Montreal, April 9, 2015 – The board of directors of the Montreal International Documentary Festival (RIDM) and Doc Circuit Montréal (DCM) is delighted to announce the appointment of Mara Gourd-Mercado to the position of executive director of the RIDM and DCM effective April 17, 2015. After a year as communications director, Ms. Mercado was ready to take on this key role within the organization.

She succeeds Roxanne Sayegh, who had led the RIDM and DCM since July 2010 and is leaving for an opportunity better suited to her life as a new mother. During her tenure, Ms. Sayegh energized the RIDM and DCM, leading to dramatic increases in attendance and a spirit of renewal that allowed the festival and market to establish themselves as essential stops on the documentary festival circuit, while also broadening the scope of the RIDM's activities.

Charlotte Selb, who has worked for the festival for more than ten years, remains programming director. She is dedicated, with renewed vigour, to the task of assembling the most impressive program possible for this year's festival.
