

Doc Lab Montréal: Call for Canadian projects now open!

Montreal, July 16, 2024 - Forum RIDM's 20th edition, presented by the **Canada Media Fund (CMF)**, announces the opening of the call for Canadian projects for Doc Lab Montréal, a catalyst for innovative documentary projects.

This call for projects, open until August 12, 2024, is aimed at emerging Canadian filmmakers with creative documentary projects in development or in the early stages of production, of any length.

From November 22 to 27, the selected Canadian participants will join international delegations for three days of closed-circuit mentorship and exchanges. Following these sessions, participants will pitch their projects to an audience of seasoned professionals from national and international markets while competing for prizes offered by Forum RIDM's partners.
