His years at the FICFA saw substantial growth in the festival's reach, numerous new partnerships in Acadia and Quebec, and the launch of training and professional development initiatives for emerging Acadian filmmakers. In 2018, he was named a Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres de la République Française for his contributions to the success of French-language cinema.

"It is an honour and a privilege to join the RIDM team. For many years, the festival has distinguished itself by its boldness and professionalism. It is fertile ground for new collaborations in everything from exhibition to career development for filmmakers — issues that are very important to me. I want to thank the board for this new mandate, which I accept with excitement and hope for the future," said Mr. Gauthier.
